Three County Fairgrounds in Northampton MA!!

The Three County Fairgrounds is located in Northampton, Massachusetts right off Interstate 91 where the scenic Holyoke Mountain Range provides the backdrop for the fifty acres of Fairgrounds hosting a 250x150 indoor arena, Adjacent covered 110x220 warm up pen and warm up is also available in the 190x220 infield area.

Two barns each housing 100 portable stalls with mats, and plenty of other stalling options available!!

Lots of area hotels & great restaurants!!

Horses & Campers will be allowed on grounds, Tuesday, April 18th after 1pm (NO EXCEPTIONS)

PLEASE MAKE NOTE You will be required to present your current AQHA membership card, any exhibitors showing your horse current membership card & horses AQHA registration papers!! IF you have an AQHA Lease you must present official letter from AQHA. You WILL NOT receive a back number until ALL INFORMATION needed is presented!

Physical cards/paper or photo are acceptable – New and Renewal memberships for AQHA and /or CQHA will be taken at the show.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS for Massachusetts: When entering the state of Massachusetts, you must meet Massachusetts Health requirements, a current Negative Coggins Test, (Within 6 months for out of state and 1 year for instate) and proof of rabies vaccine & health certificate.

PLEASE, NO TRASH IN THE MANURE PILES! - DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH! - NO DUMPING WATER BUCKETS OR WATERING STALLS! - NO MOVING STALL PANELS WITHOUT THE HELP OF THE FAIRGROUNDS!

On-Site Stabling and Camper Hook-ups available!!!

Any unit with living quarters parked overnight, whether using electricity and water or not, will be charged a camper hook-up fee. Holding tanks MUST be used – NO discharging of gray water and/or sewage.) All empty trailers must park outside of the gate.

GROUNDS RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Parking: Trailers and horses will be assigned a designated area from which to operate and to park. **There is no parking near the barns during event hours.** Fire Lanes must be kept open at all times. Unauthorized parking will be towed at the owner's expense.
- 2. Cooking, Food Preparation, Smoking Restrictions: No cooking, food preparation or smoking is allowed inside any barn or buildings.
- 3. Grounds Restrictions: Any show personnel utilizing the arena only are required to remain in the area bounded by the Barn 6 and the farthest horse barn in use by Client Association. No Horses in roped off or posted areas. All warmup & lunging must be in the specified warm up pens & arena. No Lunging of horses on grass areas. CQHA has use of the infield warm up, the covered warm up and the main arena. NO OTHER AREAS SHALL BE USED! No pools or inflatable amusements are allowed.
- 4. Postings, Signs, Attachments: No postings, signs, attachments or any articles shall be attached to any buildings without the prior written approval of the Association's Manager.
- 5. Domestic Animals: All domestic animals, including dogs and cats, shall be leashed at all times.
- 6. Electricity Usage and Restrictions: Client Association may not hook up directly to any electric panels. The Association's electrician must be notified in advance for any power hook-up needs in excess of those already provided by existing plug-in outlets. All trailers/camper hook-ups must have ground-fault connections. Therefore, only designated trailer parking areas may be used. The use of two wire extension cords and stalls fans are not allowed on the fairgrounds.
- 7. All extension cords and fans must be grounded (three wire/prong) plugs. Appliances (ie: clippers, etc) must have a UL Approval label attached. Exhibitors who refuse to remove and two wire appliances will result in a \$25 fee to the EXHIBITOR per occurrence.
- 8. Stalls: No altering of stalls unless authorized by the Association. All stall panels must be taken down by authorized Association personnel. **Unauthorized setting up or taking down of stalls is a \$300 FINE!!** Down panels or damage to stalls will be charged at a rate of \$50/panel. No staples, nails or screws in stalls. Violations for staples, nails or screws are charged a fee of \$10/stall. **No watering the stalls or dumping of water buckets in stalls.**
- 9. Manure/Trash: all trash, paper, cans, bottles, and other debris must be deposited in the dumpsters and must be kept separate from manure which must be placed in barriers. If trash is mixed with manure, Client Association shall be responsible for additional charges and fees for separating same, which may be due upon demand. All sharps and needles must be disposed of properly in the provided sharps containers. If a sharp or needle is not disposed of properly it will result in a \$250 fee to the EXHIBITOR/TRAINER per occurrence.
- 10. Motor Bikes and Golf Carts: Motor bikes, ATV's, gators and/or golf carts shall only be operated by individuals who are sixteen (16) years of age or older who have received proper training and within designated areas.
- 11. Bedding: Sawdust, pelletize sawdust, cardboard shavings and straw is not allowed on the premises for bedding, only bagged shavings are allowed on premises. In the event any sawdust, pelletized sawdust, cardboard shavings or straw is used, the cost of the removal (\$100) will be charged to the exhibitor.
- 12. Back Flow Devices: No removal of backflow devices. There will be a \$25 charge for any missing back flow device.
- 13. Aisles of all barns must be kept clear of obstructions so that persons and horse can pass.


